**\*\*Contestants competing in interview must be ready no later than 12:00 PM for interview or 3 points will be deducted per judge.**

**\*\* Contestants are welcome to do a walkthrough stage rehearsal after registration.**

**\*\*Please do not call and ask how many are in your age group. We do not have the information until after the deadline has passed. Thank you in advance.**

### Mandatory Competitions (All Divisions):

- **Doll, Baby, Wee and Tiny Miss (ages 12 months - 6 years):** Beauty & Active Wear
- **Little, Junior, Young, Teen and Miss (ages 7-26 years):** Beauty, Talent, Private Interview and Activewear

### Optional Competitions (All Divisions):

- **Doll Miss (ages 12 - 18 months):** Most Beautiful, Best Dress, Best Active Wear, Sleepwear & Photogenic
- **Baby, Wee & Tiny Miss (ages 19 months - 6 years):** Most Beautiful, Best Dress, Best Active Wear, Photogenic, Sleepwear & Talent. NOTE: The 19 months – 6 years age divisions must compete **in 4 options** of choice for Mini Majestic title. **\*\*Note:** If all 5 options are selected, we will drop the lowest option score for the Mini Supreme title.
- **Little, Junior, Young, Teen & Miss (ages 7-26 years):** Most Beautiful, Best Dress & Photogenic. **\*\*Note:** Must compete in all 3 options for Majestic Title

### Opening Number:

- The opening number will be a parade of contestants. All contestants will parade across the stage in their evening gown and then line up for beauty competition.

### Royalty Division:

We will offer a Royalty Competition (You will not win a title, but may compete for practice to the 26<sup>th</sup> Annual PONC State August 2nd-3rd, 2019.) Contestants will compete in the appropriate age division but will not be eligible for any title. The one contestant that scores the highest score between all royalty competitors will win \$100.00 cash prize. The entry fee is \$50.00. This competition is for young ladies not eligible to compete for a PONC prelim title. We must have 3 royals for \$100 cash prize payout.

### AWARDS and REQUIREMENTS:

#### Age Division Beauty Winners

- PONC Preliminary Custom Full Round Pearl and Rhinestone Crown, Monogrammed Satin Banner, Trophy, Rhinestone Crown Pin, Beauty fees paid to the Princess of NC State Scholarship Pageant August 2nd & 3rd, 2019 at Paramount Theatre in Goldsboro
- Runner-ups will receive trophy
- Optional winners will receive pins
- All Contestants will receive an award and contestants ages 6 and under will receive a tiara.

#### Overall Majestic Princess of Eastern Piedmont and Mini Majestic Princesses of Eastern Piedmont Winners:

- Contestant with the highest combined scores from the mandatory & optional competitions (Awards below):
- **Baby, Wee & Tiny Miss (ages 18 months - 6 years)** will receive a Mini Majestic Full Round Pearl and Rhinestone Crown, Monogrammed Satin Banner, Trophy, Rhinestone Crown Pin, their Beauty fee paid to the Princess of North Carolina State Scholarship Pageant August 2nd & 3rd, 2019
- **Little, Junior, Young, Teen & Miss (ages 7-26 years):** will receive a Full Majestic Round Pearl and Rhinestone Crown, Monogrammed Satin Banner, Trophy, Rhinestone Crown Pin, their Beauty fee paid to the Princess of NC State Scholarship Pageant August 2nd & 3rd, 2019.
- Must have 20 paid contestants for 2 Supreme Titles to be awarded - **The Majestic Queens will be single Title Holders.**
- **If the Majestic Queen is the Community Service queen winner, they will be recognized on stage, but will not be double crowned. The crown will go to the next contestant who raises the most money.**

#### Princess of Eastern Piedmont People's Choice

Each contestant is asked to bring a decorated box or jar with their name and picture on it. The jar that collects the most money will be crowned Princess of Eastern Piedmont People's Choice. **Each contestant may also raise money for Victory Junction prior to the pageant which will be added to your People's Choice amount to determine winners. You must turn in money raised for VJ at time of registration.** One dollar counts as one vote. The jars with the most votes collected during pageant plus prior donations will be announced at the end of the pageant. Each Winner will receive a Princess of Eastern Piedmont full round crown, monogrammed sash, rhinestone crown pin, and reign with the Princess of Eastern Piedmont Court. All proceeds from People's Choice will benefit Victory Junction. Checks may be made directly to Victory Junction.

#### Music, Score Sheets & Pictures

All photogenic pictures, talent CD's, and score sheets may be picked up by turning in your contestant number at the auditor's table following coronation.

#### Admission

- Tickets are \$10.00 at the door. The doors will open for all spectators at 1:15 P.M.
- One chaperone per contestant will enter for FREE.
- Visiting queens are welcome at no charge and they must have crown and sash current-to-date. However, chaperones must pay.

- There is a \$20.00 hair and makeup fee for each person helping the contestant in the dressing room. Space is limited to only TWO helpers per contestant. The hair and makeup or chaperone fee will also get you in the pageant. One chaperone will get in FREE.

### **Photography & Videography**

Princess of Eastern Piedmont will have a photographer and videographer available for the event if there are enough contestants. We will provide additional information closer to the pageant.

### **COMPETITION GUIDELINES**

#### **Beauty:**

- Mandatory
  - Doll, Baby, Wee, Tiny Miss (Short pageant dress, white shoes, no tights, dress socks)
  - Little Miss - (long or short, but must be long by State PONC)
  - Junior, Young, Teen and Miss - (long pageant dress)
- Make-up (All Divisions): Make-up is allowed but must be kept age appropriate and toned down. Age appropriate means to consider your age.

**Private Interview: (Mandatory Little-Miss)** - Contestants will participate in a 3 minute private personality interview. They should wear white slacks/skirt/shorts or bottoms of choice with the contestant's choice of black top/shirt but it CANNOT be embellished. Contestants may add a belt of their choice to coordinate the shirt with their white bottoms. White tennis shoes and ankle socks are recommended but older contestants may wear sandals or wedges. Three points will be deducted from each judge if a contestant is late for interview.

**Talent: (Mandatory Little-Miss/Optional Baby-Tiny)** - CD's ONLY, no tapes. No other songs on CD other than talent selection. Talent may not exceed beyond 2 ½ minutes. Label CD with contestant # and name. The song and talent must be age appropriate! Vocalists are not allowed to have background singers on their music. If you need assistance with finding a karaoke version, please let us know and we will be happy to help. Note - Always have a backup CD with you in case of emergency. Small props are allowed for talent if they can be carried on by the contestant.

**Active Wear: (Doll-Miss)** - Wear clothing, including footwear that is worn for sport or physical fitness exercise. Contestants in Doll - Junior divisions SHOULD NOT have an outfit that shows their midriff. It is allowed but not mandatory for Young, Teen and Miss Divisions to show their midriff. The activewear outfit CANNOT be embellished. Activewear will be judged on your physical fitness appearance and your choice of activewear. You will not perform a routine, but will strike a fitness pose at the X on stage left. If a contestant performs a routine, there will be three points deducted from each judge.

#### **Optional Categories:**

- Best Dress (dress only)-(Doll-Miss) will be judged during the Beauty Competition and counts only for majestic titles.
- Most Beautiful (face only)-(Doll-Tiny) will be judged during the Beauty Competition and counts only for majestic titles.
- Best Active Wear (Doll-Miss) will be judged during the Active Wear competition. based on outfit only and counts only for majestic titles.
- Sleepwear (Doll-Tiny) will be judged during the Sleepwear competition, based on outfit only and counts only

for majestic titles. (Small props allowed)

- Photogenic (Doll-Miss) Photo must be a natural, “professional” black/white or color 8x10 photograph. No enhanced photographs allowed. Makeup should be age appropriate. Pictures must be placed inside a clear cover. There will be hard plastic covers available to buy for \$5.00 each at the registration. Make sure to label the photo cover with division and contestant #. All photos should be head/or head and shoulder shots and pictures should look the age of the child! Doll & Baby Miss may be waist up. Photo(s) must be turned in at registration. If anyone forgets to pick up their photos after the pageant, please send a self-addressed postage paid envelope. Photogenic will be judged by the pageant judges on the day of the pageant before it starts.

**Program Book Ad Pages**

## **Princess of Eastern Piedmont Rules and Information**

- 1) Contestants must have a valid North Carolina address and reside in or be a resident of NC for at least six months of the year.
- 2) Contestants must be single/never married, or given birth.
- 3) Contestants and/or parents are not allowed to approach the judges at any time during the pageant.
- 4) Judges decisions are final and indisputable.
- 5) Contestants may move up one age division to compete if they or their legal guardian feel it would be in their best interest. At no time are you allowed to move down age divisions.
- 6) When turning in your contestant number, score sheets, talent CDs and photogenic pictures will be available at the auditor's table immediately following the Coronation ceremony. We will not be responsible for keeping or returning any items left behind.
- 7) No props allowed for talent competitions. Exception: a chair/stool as part of the routine or small hand held carry on object. (ask if in doubt)
- 9) H/M people are responsible for bringing their own table, chair, and extension cords, etc. When finished each H/M person is responsible for cleaning up their own area!
- 9) One chaperone and one hair/makeup person allowed backstage and they must have a pass or will be required to purchase a ticket.
- 10) Contestant numbers should be worn on the left side waist area if at all possible. The contestant may walk out with their number and lay it on the stage if it is in the way for talent competition.
- 11) Contestants must be on time for scheduled competitions. We cannot delay competitions to wait for any contestant! It is the responsibility of the chaperone to insure that the contestant is on time for each event.
- 12) Information on whom or how many are competing in any age group will not be disclosed prior to the deadline.
- 13) Please do not leave valuable items unattended in the dressing areas or restrooms! (POEP is not responsible).
- 14) No still cameras, videos, or recording devices are allowed inside the auditorium. Anyone reported to the staff for either of these violations will be asked to put their cameras away and/or removed from the auditorium! An official photographer and videographer will be available for anyone wishing to purchase photo packages or videos if there are enough contestants. There will be additional information available as the pageant time nears.
- 15) Please, no food or drinks allowed inside the auditorium at any time!
- 16) We reserve the right to disqualify any contestant or refuse entry to anyone in this or future pageant for poor sportsmanship or not honoring the duties of their title.
- 17) All 2019 Queens that are crowned will be asked to come back and entertain and give up their title at the following year's Princess of Eastern Piedmont Pageant.
- 18) Please keep all hair and makeup natural and age appropriate. No flippers for teeth.
- 19) Talent must be cd ready and on a Music CD-R.
- 20) Have Fun and let's make a Positive experience for ALL contestants and queens!
